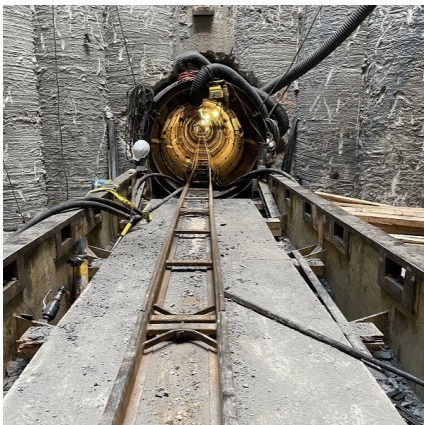


Thornton Water Project Johnstown, CO



PROJECT OVERVIEW AND CHALLENGES

Bradshaw Construction installed two 68" OD rib-and-board tunnels as part of the Thornton Water Project. The two tunnels (250' and 235') were installed underneath rivers, the Cache La Poudre River in Windsor, CO, and the Little Thompson River in Johnstown, CO. The tunnels were installed behind an Akkerman 540 TBM out of secant pile shafts. Ground conditions consisted of claystone and sandstone.
